- 5. What personal application can you make from this passage?

## John 3:1-17

#### **Discussion Starters**

- 1. Why did Nicodemus go to Jesus at night?
- 2. How is spiritual birth similar/dissimilar to physical birth?
- 3. How is spiritual birth similar to the wind?
- 4. How does one experience spiritual birth (being born again)?
- 5. What personal application would you make from this passage?
