##### **Discussion Starters**

3. Why does God give visions?
4. What questions about God's nature or purpose does Isaiah's vision raise for him (for you)?
5. What is the impact of this vision on Isaiah?
6. What personal application could you make from this passage?

#### **Romans 8:12-17**

##### **Discussion Starters**

1. What obligation(s) do we have (or not have), and why? To whom are we a debtor?
2. Describe the difference between sonship and adoption in this passage.
3. Practically speaking, what does it mean to be led by the Spirit?
4. How do you understand the difference between living according to the dictates of the flesh and living by the Spirit?
5. What personal application can you make from this passage?

#### **John 3:1-17**

##### **Discussion Starters**

1. Why did Nicodemus go to Jesus at night?
2. How is spiritual birth similar/dissimilar to physical birth?
3. How is spiritual birth similar to the wind?
4. How does one experience spiritual birth (being born again)?
5. What personal application would you make from this passage?
