Discussion Starters

- 1. What contrasts does Paul identify between the old (unredeemed) life and the new (redeemed) life?
- 2. How does one "make the most of every opportunity?"
- 3. What does it mean to "be filled with the Holy Spirit?" How does that happen?
- 4. Surely verses 19-20 don't mean that we are supposed to put on a "fake" smile when we don't feel like offering a real one! What does Paul mean?
- 5. What is something for which you give thanks? Can you thank God in everything?

John 6:51-58

- 1. What does Jesus mean by eating His flesh and drinking His blood?
- 2. What is the underlying truth that Jesus is trying to convey through His teaching about Himself as the Bread of Life?
- 3. How does feeding on Jesus bring about eternal life?
- 4. In what way is Jesus similar to manna, and how is He different?
