- 4. What does this passage say about your responsibility in the spiritual life of your family?

Discussion Starters

- 1. What are the pieces of armor for the Christian? What do each signify?
- 2. Why does the Christian need to put on armor?
- 3. How does prayer fit into the spiritual battle we face? What specific requests for prayer does Paul make?
- 4. Are the pieces of armor offensive or defensive? What does that tell you?

John 6:56-69

Discussion Starters

- 1. What teaching do the followers of Jesus find to be unacceptable?
- 2. Why do you think some disciples (such as Peter) decided to stay and why did some decide to leave?
- 3. In what way(s) does the Spirit give life?
- 4. John also calls those who turned back "disciples." How can that be?
