- 3. What does the detail about "firstfruits" suggest to you?
- 4. How does this story compare with Jesus' feeding of the 5,000? Given that Elisha did this, why did Jesus do it also?

#### **Discussion Starters**

- 1. What does Paul ask God to do?
- 2. What does the promise in verse 20 mean? How have you seen it to be true?
- 3. How would you describe "the love of Christ" to someone who has never experienced it?

## John 6:1-21

#### **Discussion Starters**

- 1. What test did Jesus give to Philip (v. 6)?
- 2. Why was there more food at the end of the meal than there was before it?
- 3. What did the disciples fail to see in the feeding of the 5,000 that could have helped them when they were in trouble on the rough seas?
