Daniel 7:9-10, 13-14

Discussion Starters

Note: This reading immediately follows Daniel's vision about the four beasts.

- 1. Who is the Ancient of Days? What do you know about him from this passage?
- 2. Who is the one like a son of man? What do you know about him from this passage?
- 3. What is the significance of verse 14, especially when understood in light of the vision of the four beasts (vv. 1-8)?
- 4. If you were an artist assigned to paint the scene described in verses 13-14, what would your painting look like?

Revelation 1:4b-8

Discussion Starters

- 1. What do you know about God from these verses? What do you know about Jesus?
- 2. What (who) is the sevenfold Spirit? Why is he described this way? (See Isaiah 11 for more clarity.)
- 3. According to this text what specifically does Jesus do for us?
- 4. Summarize the meaning of verse 7. Why is this significant?

John 18:33-37

Discussion Starters

- 1. What does Jesus tell Pilate about His kingdom? Who is included in it?
- 2. Does Jesus ever admit to being a king?
- 3. Why was the question asked by Jesus in verse 34 important for Pilate to consider? Why is it still important to us today?
