

In our current Adult Sunday School class (Elephants Donkeys and the Lamb) we have been talking about the reality that, as Christians, we find ourselves living in two different kingdoms: the spiritual kingdom of God and the temporal kingdom of this world.

Nowhere in our calendar will that reality be felt more intensely than in the first few days of November. Our month begins with our annual All Saints Day worship service. On that day we will celebrate those who have begun their faith journey through the Sacrament of Holy Baptism (also known as the "Church Militant") and those who have completed their course on earth and entered into their eternal reward (the "Church Triumphant").

And then, just two days later, we cast our votes in a very contentious presidential election.

Amazing, isn't it? Two clear and distinct events that describe the world in which people of faith live!

Throughout this election cycle, I have constantly reminded myself that Christ is still the King of kings and Lord of lord over both kingdoms. He has not ceded any power in either one, nor will He.

NOVEMBER CONGREGATIONAL MEETING

Grace will hold its next Congregational Meeting at 9:15 a.m. on Sunday, November 24. We will gather in the Grace sanctuary. This is the second of two annual meetings required in our Grace constitution.

There are three major items of business on the agenda: (1) the election of members of the Church Council; (2) the election of members to the Endowment Committee; and (3) the adoption of the 2025 ministry plan (budget).

In addition to these agenda items, you will be updated on a number of ministries and issues within the congregation, including updates on our finances, the sale of property, the impact of the Endowment grants and more. Please make your attendance a priority!

ADULT SUNDAY SCHOOL IN NOVEMBER

In November Adult Sunday School attenders will conclude their four-part study "Elephants, Donkeys and the Lamb," a conversation about how Christians can think and act Biblically in political matters.

That paves the way for a seven-week study based on Dietrich Bonhoeffer's classic book "Life Together." This course begins on November 10 with a video biography on Bonhoeffer's incredible life. The course will involve a weekly reading assignment from the Life Together book, copies of which will be available for purchase beginning November 3rd. Pastor Brodbeck will facilitate this course.'

In *Life Together*, Dietrich Bonhoeffer, renowned Christian minister, professor, and author of *The Cost of Discipleship* recounts his unique fellowship in an underground seminary during the Nazi years in Germany. Giving practical advice on how life together in Christ can be sustained in families and groups, Life Together is bread for all who are hungry for the real life of Christian fellowship.
