- 2. What specifically does Paul pray earnestly for? (The word "may" should give you some clues.)
- 3. In what ways have you been encouraged by someone else's faith?

## Luke 21:25-36

### **Discussion Starters**

- 1. What is significant about the way the Son of Man will come (v. 27)?
- 2. What, exactly, is the lesson from the fig tree?
- 3. Is this teaching of Jesus a discouragement or encouragement? Why?
- 4. According to this passage, what should Christians be doing while they wait for the return of Christ?
