2025. For some reason, that year has an aura of significance about that number, I feel as if I should think differently. What is it that catches my heart?

It is a quarter of a century. Wow. That came quickly.

If I'm counting by fives, it is a logical sequence.

In math class I was taught to round my numbers to the nearest five.

Our church will be 110 years old. That's important, but it is not usually the sort of anniversary that drives a major celebration.

It isn't a milestone birthday year for me.

Karen and I will celebrate our 45<sup>th</sup> wedding anniversary, but you don't usually throw a party for another five years.

Yet the number sticks out. Why is 2025 important? What is going to happen this year?

## JANUARY OUTREACH CORNER



#### **FAMILY ENGLISH PROGRAM UPDATE:**

December 12<sup>th</sup> was our final date for the fall pilot program teaching English to our immigrant neighbors and their families. We had a total of 80 adults registered and 46 children. Attendance did feel the impact of the election and cold weather in the last few weeks. The children played while the adults learned English. Everyone received a snack each night and even a special treat the week before Thanksgiving.

We had 21 different churches represented and over 100 volunteers with 14 coming from Grace, great job Grace!! We had good attention from the Governor's office and even a film documentary crew from LA join us one night to film some of the positive work going on in Springfield with our immigrant families. High Street Nazarene church and Family English was also the recipient of one of the ten driving simulators given to Springfield to help educate our new neighbors on driving. The feedback from the volunteers who participated was overwhelmingly positive with wonderful new relationships built between churches and with our immigrant friends. We are currently working to decide on the next steps and hope to offer three sessions next year, spring, summer and fall. Stay tuned for more information.

#### WHAT IS STEPHEN MINISTRY?

Grace has offered Stephen Ministry for nearly 20 years now. But I'm often asked "What exactly is a Stephen Minister?" Stephen Ministers are trained lay caregivers who provide emotional and spiritual support to people going through difficult times in life, providing hope and healing in the midst of their pain.

Stephen Ministers are sometimes called "The After People" because they are there:

After the phone call in the middle of the night that changes life forever

After the baby comes home, demanding more than you ever imagined

After the funeral, when everyone has left, and your emotions come crashing in

After the email announcing a new round of layoffs

After the doctor says, "I'm sorry, but there's nothing else we can do

After the youngest child pulls out of the hug and heads into the dorm—followed by a long drive back to an empty house

After the divorce papers are served

After the fire, when rebuilding a home feels impossible

After family and friends have heard your story one too many times but you still need to talk it out.
