Pastor's Reflection

I come from a family of storytellers. My Grandpa Brodbeck was a master. Even though I was only five when he died, his stories live on in my memory. Especially the one about the ghost of Eli. Any skill I have in this area comes from him.

His stories were mostly fictional involving characters he made up or events that were (very) loosely based on some news event. But he told them with such conviction and energy you always believed they were true.

Grandpa taught me about the power of a story. He did it unintentionally, of course, but I learned the lesson. A good story will capture your attention and through them people come together and relationships are built.

That's one of the reasons your faith story is so important. As you tell what God has done for you or through you, you capture the ears of people who need to hear what you have to share. And in your words, God captures their hearts.


