- 4. What is "an instructed tongue?"

# Philippians 2:1-11

#### **Discussion Starters**

- 1. If you were to read between the lines, what problems could you identify within the Philippian Church?
- 2. What does it mean to consider someone "better than yourself?" Is that mentally and emotionally healthy? How does humility differ from being a doormat for people to walk over?
- 3. What does it mean (in verse 7) to "empty" yourself?
- 4. What do you think it was like for Jesus to leave heaven and become human?
- 5. What did Jesus accomplish by leaving heaven and becoming a human that could not have been accomplished any other way?
- 6. If every tongue will confess "Jesus is Lord" does that mean every person will go to heaven? Why or why not?

# Luke 22:39-54

# **Discussion Starters**

- 1. What strikes you the most about the prayer of Jesus?
- 2. What does it mean practically to pray "your will be done?"
- 3. What was the crowd so large and armed? What do they fear? Why are their fears unnecessary?
- 4. What does Jesus mean by "your hour" (v. 53)? Whose hour? How does darkness reign?
