Job Description: Director of Youth Ministry

Position Overview

Grace Evangelical Lutheran Church is seeking a passionate and dynamic Director of Youth Ministry to lead and nurture the faith of our 7th through 12th grade youth.

This person will be the key advocate for our youth, fostering an environment where they can grow in faith, develop into leaders, and live out Christian values in their schools, homes, and communities.

This is a **flexible part-time to full-time** (25–40 hours/week) salaried position, with final hours and compensation based on the candidate's availability and experience.

Key Responsibilities

1. Cultivating Faith & Discipleship

Help youth (grades 7–12) grow in their walk with Jesus through weekly gatherings, retreats, mission trips, and key milestones like Faith Journey, Confirmation, and Commissioning. Every experience is centered on discipleship and helping students take ownership of their faith.

2. Empowering Leaders & Building Community

You won't do this alone—your role is to recruit, equip, and encourage a team of adult leaders who will mentor and walk with youth. Together, you'll create a Christ-centered community where students feel known, valued, and connected.
