#### **Discussion Starters**

- 1. The image of a mother is used here to describe God's relationship with His children. Who are these children?
- 2. What does the idea of "God as mother" convey to you? In what way(s) is it an appropriate to convey who God is?
- 3. How is that image different from "God as father?"
- 4. Is God male or female? How do you know?
- 5. Why do we usually refer to God as a "he?"

# Galatians 6:1-16

#### **Discussion Starters**

- 1. What does it mean to "restore" someone who has sinned? How is it possible to do that without coming across as "holier than thou" or morally superior?
- 2. What is the connection between verse 5 and verse 2? Are they contradictory?
- 3. What does the author mean when he instructs us to carry each other's burdens?
- 4. Put verse 15into your own words. What is the author attempting to teach his readers?
- 5. Based on these verses, what are the differences between someone who lives as a follower of Jesus and one who does not?

## Luke 10:1-20

#### **Discussion Starters**

- 1. Why do you think Jesus sent his disciples out two-by-two instead of individually?
- 2. How is a follower of Jesus like a worker at harvest time?
- 3. What is the purpose of "traveling light?"
- 4. What in these verses suggests there is an urgency about the work of evangelism? What are the reasons for this urgency?
- 5. How would you summarize the words of Jesus to His disciples after they returned (vv. 18-20)?
