- 1. What does "living in Christ" involve?
- 2. What does the phrase "rooted and built up" imply?
- 3. What are the "basic principles of this world?"
- 4. How can you identify a "deceptive philosophy?"
- 5. How might one lose its connection to the Head (v. 19)?
- 6. What is Paul teaching in vv. 16-17?

Luke 11:1-13

Discussion Starters

- 1. What motivated the disciples to ask Jesus to teach them how to pray?
- 2. In this version of the Lord's Prayer, what personal requests are made? Which ones are omitted as compared to the version in Matthew 6?
- 3. What does the parable in vv. 5-8 teach regarding prayer? How does it relate to the prayer Jesus just taught His disciples?
- 4. What do vv. 9-10 teach regarding prayer?
- 5. Do these verses teach that we will get everything we ask for when we pray?
