Discussion Starters

- 2. How does "security" relate to "complacency" in this passage? What problem does this identify?
- 3. Where did the people find their security? Where should they have found it? How does that happen?
- 4. Who does Amos say will be the first to go into exile? Why?
- 5. Which is the more accurate description of God: (1) He blesses the faithful or (2) He defends the helpless?
- 6. What applications can we make from this passage for our world, our church and our lives?

1 Timothy 6:6-19

Discussion Starters

- 1. Is there a difference between loving money and simply enjoying it?
- 2. What is the "great gain" that comes with contentment?
- 3. What is Timothy told to flee? To pursue? How does one pursue such qualities?
- 4. Why does Paul use battle imagery in verse 12?
- 5. Why do you think Paul added additional instructions for the wealthy at the end of this passage?

Luke 16:19-31

Discussion Starters

- 1. How do the lives of the rich man and Lazarus compare in life? After their deaths?
- 2. What determines how one gets into heaven? What did the poor beggar have that the rich man did not?
- 3. What does this passage teach about life after death?
- 4. Since a lack of knowledge is not the problem for the brothers of the rich man, what is? Do people today suffer from a lack of knowledge?
- 5. Why is it so difficult for people to do things God's way?
