Storms can be scary but nonetheless I have always been fascinated by those bold strikes of lighting that sear across the nighttime sky. In a dramatic flash the pitch black of midnight becomes as bright as a noon day sun. Streetlights even go out, fooled by the surprising burst!

That is the image I want to create as we begin our Advent journey together. Our theme for Advent 2025 will be "Shining into the Darkness." Throughout Advent, Christmas and into Epiphany, I want our worship to convey the idea that God sent Jesus into a world that was becoming increasingly dark due to the power of sin. He did so by breaking into that darkness with the Light of the Gospel. More than just lighting a candle, God pierced the darkness of the world with a huge lightning bolt of grace. Picture the difference!

Our primary theme verse is 1 Peter 2:9:

You are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's special possession, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light. (1 Peter 2:9)

This secondary theme verse will orient our midweek and Christmas Eve services:

The people walking in darkness have seen a great light; on those living in the land of deep darkness a light has dawned. (Isaiah 9:2)

I look forward to celebrating this special season with all of you!

Please take a moment to wish her well and express your gratitude as well.


YOUNG AT HEART

THE STAR OF BETHLEHEM

Could it be true? Can we prove it? The Biblical record proclaims that mysterious star arose in the east, prompting wise men to travel and worship the newborn Jesus.

The Star of Bethlehem is a 2007 documentary by Rick Larson, revealing what he discovered when he searched for clues about the astrological phenomenon described in Matthew 2. Using the Starry Night astronomy computer program and other scientific documentation, including the Biblical record, Larson sought to answer these fascinating questions.

We will be showing his search on Sunday, December 7 at 6 p.m. in the Grace Community Center.
